General Application Materials

- Completed [application form](#)
- \$50 nonrefundable application fee
- Copies of undergraduate transcripts for all schools attended. All final, official transcripts must be received prior to the start of your first semester
- Copy of college diploma or proof of degree
- [International student requirements](#): English proficiency, transcript evaluation, and TOEFL score of 79.

Admissions Requirements

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution, with a GPA of 2.85 or higher on a 4.0 scale
 - Applicants who do not qualify for full matriculation and have an undergraduate GPA between 2.5 and 2.84 may be conditionally admitted at the discretion of the program director
- As data science is an interdisciplinary field, we welcome applicants from diverse professional backgrounds. However, applicants should have the following prerequisites:
 - One computer programming course
 - One college-level statistics course
 - Basic linear algebra
 - Basic database systems
- Students with an insufficient background for direct admission into the [Online Data Science, M.S. program](#) may be admitted if they take the required prerequisite course(s), with the approval of the director
- Transfer credits: You may transfer up to six transfer credits from an accredited graduate program for appropriate courses in which a minimum grade of B was earned
